

<b>PIR Agency:</b>	Aftercare
<b>Date:</b>	Feb 2015 - Ongoing
<b>Key issue(s)</b>	limited AOD support service on the Peninsula - demand is surplus to availability
<b>Main Objective(s)</b>	Improve the capacity or number of services available in the area.
<b>Summary of Impact or Result</b>	Resulted in supporting DrugArm to deliver services in the area i.e. increased the availability of AOD services for consumers
<b>Context</b>	Experience to date, indicates that there is a lack of referral/support options for persons with AOD issues. ADFQ were defunded as an AOD service in Redcliffe mid 2014, this has contributed to a shortfall in service availability for clients requiring support for their drug related recovery
<b>Stakeholders/Partnerships</b>	Encircle, DrugArm, Aftercare PIR
<b>Project Management</b>	This was a 3 phase project. These phases where-  1) Determine what currently exists. 2) Establish key partners 3) Devise a strategy to engage and encourage services to deliver in the area
<b>Description of Activities</b>	Additional AOD services in the area; increase opportunities for participants to access services
<b>Project Impact</b>	Yes, I hope so! It is currently self-sustaining but this could change depending on what happens to DrugArm in the wider economic environment
<b>Lessons Learned</b>	No funds were allocated; time has been allocated by the SSF, this has been challenging given all the other commitments associated with the role. Otherwise, it relatively smooth process.
